



DUNSTON LADIES CRAFT & CHAT CLUB

MEMBERS INFORMATION

1. Dunston Ladies Craft and Chat Club meet on every second Tuesday afternoon at Dunston Village Hall between 2pm and 4pm.
2. Membership fees are currently £12 per year (reviewable annually at the AGM) and are payable at the first meeting of each year in January.
3. Subscriptions of £1 will be payable at each meeting attended.
4. A diary will be produced annually whereby members can append any additional meetings, workshops or events.
5. Members will be asked to provide light refreshments for afternoon meetings on a rota basis – in an attempt to keep costs of running meetings to a minimum.
6. Members are required to assist with the preparation of the meeting (i.e. laying out chairs and tables etc.) and also to make clean the room after the meeting; where necessary sweeping the floor, cleaning the kitchen, and returning all goods to the store cupboards.
7. The AGM will take place on the first Tuesday meeting each year.
8. ALL applications to join the Dunston Ladies Craft and Chat Club must be in writing to the Chairperson. The Committee and members will then discuss the application for membership and decide upon each application accordingly. In the event of the members having a split decision the Chairperson will have a casting vote. Any decision will then be FINAL and no appeal process will be entertained.
9. Any craft that is deemed dangerous – such as toxic fumes being expelled etc., or which may cause damage to the Village Hall will not be allowed.
10. Members will be expected to conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times. Any poor behaviour or inconsiderate behaviour towards others will not be tolerated. Anyone in breach of this rule will be discussed by the Committee and may lead to a revocation of membership. In this instance there will be no appeal and no refund of any fees paid.
